Narrative Scene Structure Basics

Protagonist: The main character. He or she has a goal—something he or she wants.

Antagonist: The person or obstacle standing in the way of the goal that creates conflict.

Supporting Characters: Either help or hinder the protagonist in achieving his or her goal.

Character Beat: A change in action or behavior by a character, usually the protagonist. Often, this takes the form of another tactic for achieving the goal.

Want vs. Need: A character begins a scene **wanting** something, but ends up getting what he or she **needs.** This is the **twist** of a well-mounted scene with good conflict and an unexpected but satisfying resolution. Try to think of your character's **want** or **need** in each scene, and in the film as a whole.
